This version of the Code includes only the ceremonies for the Installation of Officers of a Royal Arch Chapter and for a Lodge of Mark Masters. All other ceremonies can be found in the full version of the Code which can be downloaded from Grand View or obtained from the office of the Grand Secretary.

Introductions - General Considerations

- If the group is large, introduce past officers as a group, then active officers as a group.
- Grand Honors are given at the Altar.
- NO ONE is given Grand Honors after the official visitor, except at his specific request or consent.
- Do not ask someone entitled to Grand Honors if he wants them. He cannot properly say "No", nor can he properly say "Yes".

Introductions – Recommended Protocol

- Past High Priests of this Chapter (at their place or at Altar)
- 1st time visitors to this Chapter (at Altar)
- Military Veterans (Applause at seats or Grand Honors at Altar)
- Visiting Past High Priests of other Chapters (at Altar)
- Optional Other visiting companions from other chapters (rise in their place)

Introductions – Recommended Protocol

- Past & Present Presiding Officers of other Masonic bodies (at Altar)
- 50 Year Masons (Applause at seats or Grand Honors at Altar)
- Officers of your District Association (at Altar)
- Past & Present Grand Officers of other grand bodies,
 Knights of the York Cross of Honor & Illustrious 33° Masons (Grand Honors at Altar)



Exceptions were made when it was determined that the lodge and chapter met on the same night. In which case, the next closest chapter was identified as being closest.

There is a concern that as Chapters, we tend to focus on drawing members from blue lodges that meet in our own building and losing awareness that we may be the logical option for members of another lodge maybe 10 miles away. The Grand Chapter Committee on Membership recommends that a companion of your chapter be appointed to be a membership ambassador to each lodge identified above.

Every brother of every blue lodge should know the location of the nearest Chapter and who to contact to assist them in continuing their Masonic journey and completing the story begun in the Master Mason Degree.
